Meeting Notes from January 4, 2012

PRAYER, PLEDGE & 4-WAY TEST: Chris Poynter

FELLOWSHIP REPORT: Hervey Howell reported 50 members and two guests present. Guests included Jason Brand, guest of **Fred May** and/or **Kyle Aud**, and Jim Francis, guest of **Levi Reames**.

PROGRAM: Chris Poynter introduced the program speaker – Steve Winkler with the Cliff Hagan Boys & Girls Club. Boys and Girls Clubs have been in existence for 105 years, beginning when a group of ladies decided to serve local boys milk and cookies after school and play games with them. The organization now serves 43 million kids. The Owensboro Club began 48 years ago. Cliff Hagan once commented that the greatest thing he has done with his life is to give his name to this club. This from a guy who was on an Olympics basketball team and is in the Basketball Hall of Fame; who led his teams to win a high school state basketball championship, NCAA college basketball championship and an NBA championship.

Before coming to the Boys & Girls Club 12 years ago, Steve Winkler was an educator and principal. Boys and Girls Clubs that formerly served the disadvantaged children, are now serving all levels of children including those from single parent homes or homes where both parents work. The local club serves 3,000 children with a fun, safe place to play and learn. It provides programs on career development, teen dropout prevention, finances, character, leadership, preventing drug and alcohol addictions, healthy lifestyles and the danger of obesity. The club partners with other organizations in those endeavors. The statue in front of their building says it all: "The future belongs to those who believe in the beauty of their children."

Steve made a big hit by awarding door prizes: a cap, basketball card and basketball autographed by the man himself, Cliff Hagan.
