**ANNOUNCEMENTS:** This year's District Conference will be held May 28-31 in Frankfort, KY. All are welcome to attend. See **President Tom Smith** for more information.

**PROGRAM:** **Tish Correa-Osborne** introduced Bernie Hale, Director of Public Relations for Owensboro Community and Technical College. Bernie provided an overview of OCTC's Discover College program. The program helps transition high school students into post-secondary education by providing opportunities for students to earn college credit by *discovering* college while in high school. Four areas of Discover College are Campus-Based Technical Programs, School-Based Technical Programs, Campus-Based Transfer Programs, and School-Based Transfer Programs. Discover College currently serves six different counties with the greatest number of students from Daviess County. The program makes up 1/3 of the total OCTC enrollment. It is the goal of OCTC to provide every local high school student with at least one credit of college work by high school graduation. Some exciting Discover College programs include Project Lead the Way (hands on teaching), Nursetrack, Mechatronics, and Biotechnology.
