Your President Speaks...

Last week James Robinson, Executive Director of the Western Kentucky International Center in Bowling Green, gave us some enlightening information on the Refugee Program in the United States. The national program was started in 1981 and the Western Kentucky Center opened in 2006. Refugees are legally documented people who wait anywhere from three to thirty-five years to come to the US. Their backgrounds have been checked by the FBI and Homeland Security in the application process. Each October, the US president declares how many refugees will be allowed to come into the country the following year. President Obama set that number at 80,000 last fall. In order to travel here from the refugee camps, refugees borrow the money for the trip. They have to start paying it back within six months of their arrival. Within 90 days, the goal is to have the refugees settled, employed and self-sufficient. Over the last ten years, refugees in the Bowling Green area have purchased 1,100 homes and added businesses of their own as well as being employed. In the last twelve months, they have generated 95 new apartment rentals and filled 195 jobs. Two satellite offices were approved last year, one of them in Owensboro due to our community involvement, cost of living and being a great place to raise a family. In the first year of our program we can expect 100-125 refugees, building up and leveling off at about 200 in the next few years. Very interesting and informative program.
